Foliage	Blue-green stems and leaves with a white powder cast.
Mature Height	9-12"
Mature Spread	9-12"

Growth Rate	Medium growing.

Flower Color	Tan seed heads when mature
Fall Color	Turns tan in the fall. Dies back in the winter.
