Common Name	Snow Queen Iris
Botanical Name	Iris sibirica 'Snow Queen'
Foliage	Leaves are medium green.
Mature Height	24"
Mature Spread	32"
Soil	Moist, well drained soil.
Zones	3 through 9
Mature Form	Upright
Growth Rate	Medium growing
Sun Exposure	 
Bloom Time	Mid Spring to Late Spring
Flower Color	White with a touch of yellow next to the stem with no beard.
Fall Color	Foliage turns yellow in the fall. Dies back for the winter.
Characteristics	    Toxic if ingested.
