Botanical Name	<b>Iris germanica 'That's All Folks'</b>
Foliage	<b>Leaves are medium green.</b>
Mature Height	<b>3' - 4'</b>
Mature Spread	<b>1' - 2'</b>
Soil	<b>Moist well drained soil.</b>
Zones	<b>3 through 9</b>
Mature Form	<b>Upright</b>
Growth Rate	<b>Medium growing</b>
Sun Exposure	 
Bloom Time	<b>Late Spring to Early Summer</b>
Flower Color	<b>Yellow with a white beard.</b>
Fall Color	<b>Foliage turns yellow in the fall. Dies back for the winter.</b>
