Common Name	Valentine Bleeding Heart
Botanical Name	Dicentra spectabilis 'Valentine'
Foliage	Finely dissected leaves in green with a plum tint and dark red stems.
Mature Height	24-36"
Mature Spread	18-30"
Soil	Moist, fertile, rich in organic matter, good drainage.
Zones	2 through 9
Mature Form	Mounding
Growth Rate	Medium growing
Sun Exposure	
Bloom Time	Mid to late spring
Flower Color	Red with white panicles
Fall Color	Leaves turn yellow in the fall. Dies back in the winter.
