Botanical Name	Lupinus polyphyllus
Foliage	Dark green foliage. Leaves resemble palm fronds.
Mature Height	2' - 3'
Mature Spread	2'
Soil	Moist, well drained, loamy soil.
Zones	4 through 9
Mature Form	Upright
Growth Rate	Fast growing
Sun Exposure	 
Bloom Time	Spring to Early Summer
Flower Color	Royal purple and white
Fall Color	No significant fall color. Dies back during the winter
Characteristics	     Toxic if ingested.
